_____ **UTTERLY OTTERLY DAY** / Ages: 3 and up/ Grades PreK-2 / hardcover \$19

One summer day, Little Otter thinks he's a "big otter now," but when his curiosity leads to danger, he learns he needs his family, no matter how big he grows. Illustrations by Ard Hoyt.

_____ **UTTERLY OTTERLY NIGHT** / Ages: 3 and up/ Grades PreK-2 / hardcover \$17

One winter night, Little Otter's ready to play, in an utterly otterly way. But can Little Otter save his family when wolves come prowling? *NY Times* featured title. Ill. by Ard Hoyt.

_____ **THE HUNTER: A Chinese Folktale Retold** / ALA Notable "For All Ages." / hardcover \$20

When his beloved village is threatened by a flood, Hai Li Bu is faced with a terrible decision: to save his own life or save his village. Illustrated by Caldecott winner Ed Young.

_____ **WAKE UP, ISLAND:** For All Ages / hardcover / \$15

As the sun rises, an island comes to life: doe and fawn, moose and calf, loon, raven, red squirrel, and a child wakes up to "maple syrup, blueberry pancakes." Woodcuts by Nick Wroblewski.

At her new school, Chrissa tries to ignore the teasing. She loves caring for Nana's baby llamas and joining the swim team with her brother. But when teasing turns into serious bullying, Chrissa must find the courage to stand strong and speak out. (Inspired the HBO DVD, *Chrissa Stands Strong!*)

_____ **MOOSE TRACKS** / For readers 8-12+ / paperback / \$10
When 12-year-old Seth Jacobsen comes face-to-face with poachers, he must choose between saving a moose calf and putting his family in harm's way. "A fast-paced adventure!"

_____ **WOLF SHADOWS** / For readers 8-12+ / paperback / \$10
When Matt takes out his frustration by shooting a wolf, Seth has an important decision to make. Is friendship more important than upholding the law? A can't put down story!

_____ **STEALING THUNDER** / For readers 8-12+ / paperback / \$10
Libby fears the horse she loves is being mistreated, but the only one who takes her seriously is a boy named Griff. What risks would you take to save an animal you love?

_____ **RIOT** / For readers 11 and up / paperback / \$10
Bryan Grant, 12, must make difficult choices when his hockey-coach dad and northern Minnesota town spin out of control. Based on true events, this is the story of a labor dispute turned violent.

_____ **WHEN EAGLES FALL** / For readers 11 and up / paperback \$10
When Alex lost her younger brother to cancer, everything fell apart. Sent to spend time with her father, an eagle researcher, a storm sweeps her – and an injured eaglet – into the wilderness.

_____ **CURSE OF A WINTER MOON** / For readers 11 and up / paperback \$10

Villagers are certain Marius's younger brother is a werewolf, or *loup garou*. It's a dark and dangerous time in history, and Marius struggles to keep himself – and Jean Pierre – alive.

_____ **FROZEN** / For readers **13 to adult** / paper \$12

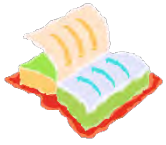

_____ **ICE-OUT** / For readers **13 to adult** / paperback \$12

At 19 years old, Owen Jensen is determined to make something of himself--but Prohibition is in full swing on the northern border, and neither law enforcement nor bootleggers hold the moral high ground. This fast-paced coming-of-age novel confronts the price of blind ambition, the destructive nature of secrecy, and the redemptive power of love.

_____ **WATERFALL** / For adults and 14 and older) hardcover \$22 / paperback \$16

Trinity Baird's life is shattered after her wealthy parents sent her to an asylum. She's 21 when she returns to her family's summer island home and yearns to pursue her art studies in the fall in Paris, but her summer is fraught with challenges as her parents threaten to send her back at the least sign of independence or "unacceptable" behavior. The Mpls Star Tribune calls it the "Great Gatsby" of the North.
